B.R.A.I.N stands for:

BRAIN SCIENCE AND RESEARCH – how difficult children think, why they feel and act the way they do, what parts of their brain they do not use and how to help them think rather than react.

RESILIENCY TRAINING – how to help children learn how to handle adversity and bounce back from abuse, trauma and other problems, rather than making the situation worse with problem behaviour.

ATTACHMENT BUILDING – connecting with adults is the key to handling stress and feeling the support that is required for a life of fun and enjoyment.

INTERVENTIONS THAT WORK – the four key elements of interventions that work with challenging children.

NEUROLOGICAL REPARATIVE THERAPY – rather than changing the child's behaviour, this approach outlines the steps that are necessary to change the child's brain which in turn shifts the perceptions, the emotions and the behaviours of children for long term change.

"The B.R.A.I.N Workshop - Changing Difficult Children from the Inside Out" will explain what is going on inside the child's mind and will provide many interventions that are designed to make permanent changes for the better. The focus will be on practical application and interventions will be provided for every step along the way to a more positive present and future for the child.
